

THE TIBOR & SHEILA HOLLO CHARITABLE FOUNDATION DONATES \$75,000 TO LAUNCH DR. OZ'S HEALTHCORPS AT HALLANDALE MAGNET HIGH SCHOOL

Broward County School Board representatives and Hallandale Beach city officials gathered at Hallandale Magnet High School, where the Tibor & Sheila Hollo Charitable Foundation presented a \$75,000 donation to bring the unique HealthCorps® program to the high school. HealthCorps is a 501(c)(3) organization founded in 2003 by heart surgeon and Daytime Emmy Award-winning host Dr. Mehmet Oz and his wife Lisa to combat the childhood obesity crisis.

This is the sixth year that the Tibor & Sheila Hollo Charitable Foundation has donated \$75,000 to bring the HealthCorps program to a South Florida high school. The generous donation also will bring HealthCorps University (HCU) training, which is a professional development program, to additional schools in Broward County.
