Views of the East River and Manhattan's skyline can be seen from all corners of the penthouse, including the master suite which has a sublime master bath dressed entirely in white Caldia Classico marble. The chef's kitchen will inspire many gastronomic creations with its natural Brazilian quartzite countertops, Lefroy Brooks hardware, millwork cabinetry, and Gaggenau appliances. High ceilings, custom moldings, solid Appalachian oak herringbone flooring, and a vast array of windows combine to produce a fresh and airy residence. Residents of 20 East End Avenue will have access to a variety of building amenities such as a spa, fitness center, and billiards room. Penthouse A is currently listed at \$35 million.
