Miami has reached new heights, adding to its skyline the tallest building in Florida and the tallest residential project south of Manhattan.

Looking over downtown Brickell Avenue, the 85-story Panorama Tower, at 1100 Brickell Bay Drive, includes 821 rental units served by 45,000 square feet of amenities, 208 hotel rooms by Hyatt Centric, a 2,000-car parking garage, 100,000 square feet of medical office space, and high-end retail outlets and restaurant space spanning about 50,000 square feet.

The entire project, built by developer [Tibor Hollo](#)'s Florida East Coast Realty, is expected to cost about \$800 million. Wells Fargo led the lending syndication.

“Live, work, play” was the idea that propelled Panorama, first conceptualized by FECR about seven years ago, Executive VP [Jerome Hollo](#) said.

“It’s a microcosm of what Brickell is now,” he said.
