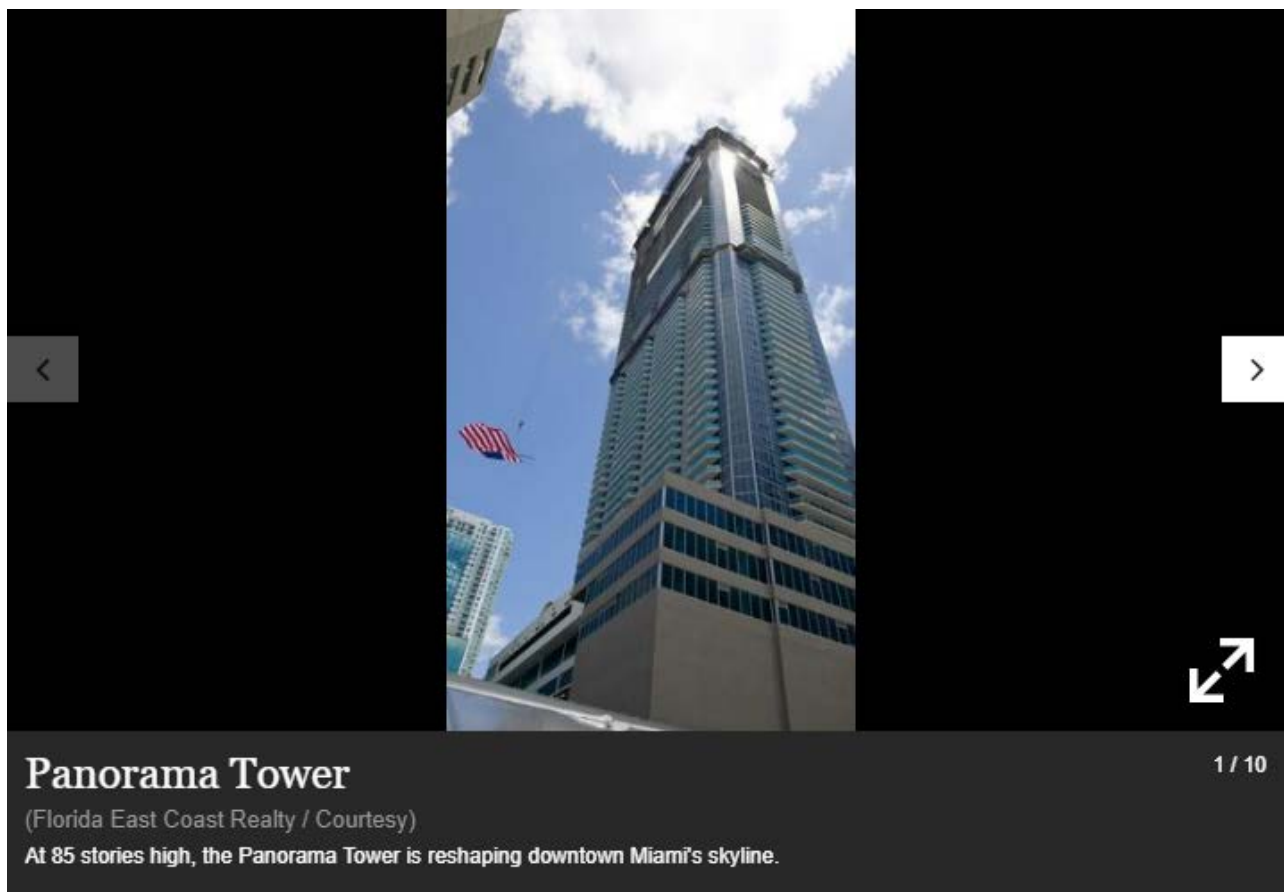

Miami's new Panorama Tower to be tallest building in Florida



Miami is growing up.

Downtown commuters and denizens may have noticed the Panorama Tower looming large over the skyline. This past spring, Florida East Coast Realty officially topped off the 85-story luxury rental development, which will have 821 units.

When completed in October, it will rise 868 feet (including antenna) over the skyline, overtaking the Four Seasons Hotel Miami, which has been the tallest building in Florida.

Those bragging rights will now belong to the Panorama.
