The new Panorama Tower in Miami is the tallest building in Florida and south of Manhattan, according to its developers. It overtook the Four Seasons Hotel and Tower in Miami, which has been the tallest building in Florida at 800 feet. The tallest building in Broward county is The Beach Club Two which is 54-stories high and about 510 feet high in Hallandale Beach. And the tallest in Palm Beach County is the Tiara Condominium which rises 42 stories high or about 400 feet high in Riviera Beach.
