Brickell's Supertall Towers By Foster & Partners Resubmitted To The FAA At 1,049 Feet

Plans to build two supertall towers in Brickell have been resubmitted to the Federal Aviation Administration.

The Tower by Foster and Partners is a joint project of McCourt Global and Tibor Hollo's Florida East Coast Realty.

According to the newly filed application submitted November 18, the project will rise 1,044 feet above ground, or 1,049 feet above sea level.

A construction schedule attached to the application says that work is planned to begin in November 2021, with completion in December 2024.

No construction permit for the property appears to be pending as of today.

The Towers by Foster and Partners is proposed to include residential, with an optional hotel.

The project had already been approved by the at 1,049 feet in 2016, but that approval expired.

Hollo also obtained FAA approval in January 2020 for another supertall building on Biscayne Boulevard, called One Bayfront Plaza. That tower is also approved to rise 1,044 feet above ground, or 1,049 feet above sea level.















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
