MIAMI HONORS HOLLO: A35,000-square-foot park at 1814 Brickell Ave.

has been named in honor of **Tibor Hollo**, 95-year-old Holocaust survivor and American real estate developer who laid stones that established the Brickell of today. The Miami City Commission voted unanimously to bestow the honor as Mr. Hollo vastly contributed to development of the city. In 1969, he built the first high-rise office building in Brickell, Rivergate Plaza, a landmark cornerstone of Miami's financial marketplace. He founded Florida East Coast Realty in 1972. Over the decades, Mr. Hollo developed numerous projects in the

city, including the Bay Parc Plaza, Venetia/The Grand, Vizcaya Towers, the Biscayne Bay Marriott, and Miami's current tallest building, the 868-foot Panorama Tower.
